SUMMARY REPORT
on
THE PROTECTION OF NATURE
IN SOUTH VIETNAM

- In 1958: The Trang-Bom National Park (316 hectares) was established.
- On 5.25.1959: Decree No. 175/BCN/ND/HC.2 was issued, fixing:
 - a. A list of animals and birds to be protected, all hunting or capture being prohibited.
 - b. A list of animals, the hunting of which to be limited.
 - c. The establishment of 5 game reserves:
 - 1. The Krong-Poko Reserve: 533,760 hectares.
 - 2. The Pleiku-Plei Ta-Nan Xer Reserve: 56,480 ha.
 - 3. The Bantur Reserve: 27,840 ha.
 - 4. The Kim-Duc Reserve: 53,760 ha.
 - 5. The Lang-Bien Reserve: 4,800 ha.
- On 6.25.1962: Decree No. 274/BCN/ND/HC.I was issued, fixing the organisation and operation of the National Parks.
- Under study is the establishment of the Bach-Mã - Hai-Vân National Park of 78,000 hectares.
