Dear Dr. Lehmann:

Since I have not been in Washington for some weeks, I have not received your reply to my last letter covering what I thought I could contribute in any preliminary visit to Colombia. I will assume that the reply is favorable.

Thus I propose to visit Bogota for one week beginning on May 31 and ending on June 6. I propose to arrive in Bogota during the evening of May 30 and be ready for our first meeting that evening or first thing in the morning on the 31st. I will leave Bogota sometime during the day of June 7.

If for any reason there is no desire for my kind of exploratory visit, or if the time schedule is completely unreasonable in view of your commitments, I would appreciate your sending a note to the above address, attention Mrs. Packard, who will attempt to establish my itinerary.

I hope that our scheduling will work out as I am looking forward to our first meeting and a thorough exploration of the national park problems facing Colombia.
